Freestone Vineyards was founded in 1999 when the Joseph Phelps family and management team broke ground on approximately 100 acres near the town of Freestone in the Sonoma Coast appellation with a goal of creating a winery to produce outstanding Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. At Freestone Vineyards, developing and applying biodynamic farming practices is an opportunity to fully express the regional characteristics of the soil, climate, and terrain within the context of what nature provides. Careful picking and sorting by hand encourages fresh and pure fruit expression. The first wines from Freestone Vineyards were released in 2006 and the winery was completed in time for the 2007 harvest.

Wines: Freestone wines are grown on the winery's 100-acre Sonoma Coast estate and are comprised of Pastorale Vineyard – formerly called Freestone – (53 acres), Quarter Moon (41 acres) and Ferguson (a 6-acre leased vineyard).
